Effective Immediately

Action Required All lithium battery powered data loggers must be properly declared,

documented, and secured onto or within your shipment.

## Overview

It is the Shippers responsibility when using the following Verigo data loggers to follow all of the requirements outlined in IATA Packing Instruction 967 for Section II lithium ion and lithium polymer batteries contained in equipment (UN3481) to include, but not limited to, certification on an air waybill and the application of the lithium battery handling label on the shipment.

- Pod Temp
- Pod Humidity
- Pod One-90
- Pod Probe

Shippers using data loggers are required to secure the tracking device in an authorized location on the shipment to prevent movement during transportation and handling. Shipments containing data loggers in an unauthorized location on a shipment will be refused.

Any shipment containing a data logger with a lithium power source that is not properly declared, marked and/or labeled in accordance with PI 967 will be refused.

Shipments containing data loggers that appear to be broken, cracked, or otherwise damaged will be refused.
